

2011-2012 USBC TWELVE GAME TOURNAMENT

1. Tournament starts **Sunday, November 6,, 2011** and continues until **Saturday, December 24, 2011 (not including the week of Thanksgiving)**. **Entries close November 4, 2011.**
2. Open to all adult members of the Franklin County USBC Bowling Association.
3. **Bowl twelve games over a six week period** through regular league bowling. The twelve games must be bowled within a single league. The highest four series will be counted.
4. This will be handicap division only.
5. There is a one-time **entry fee of \$20.00 for each entry** which must be paid before any scores can be counted.
6. Handicaps will be 100% of 240 for both men and women.
7. Averages used will be the **highest average of all leagues** in which 21 or more games were bowled in the fall 2010/2011 season (excluding summer leagues). If you do not have a previous average, we will use your **highest average of all present leagues** in which 21 or more games were bowled in the summer and fall of 2011 seasons. If the bowler does not have at least 21 games toward average, then **they must bowl scratch.**
8. Qualifiers will be the **top third of all entrants**. Qualifiers will bowl in a 2 game roll off, followed immediately by a Stepladder format for the top five on **Saturday, January 7, 2012 at 1:00PM.**
9. Bowlers may enter more than once (through more than one league), but may qualify only once. We must have no less than 30 entrants to hold this event.
10. **No refunds** will be given for not completing the tournament. Bowlers may petition the tournament committee for a waiver if physically unable to complete the tournament.
